Int Hi, Steven. How are you?

P Hello. I'm okay, are you alright?

I think it's a massive commitment. But yeah, in answer to your question, if I could master that instantly, that'd be really, really cool.

Int Sounds like a huge undertaking, for sure. Do you have any other hobbies out of interest, or is it just music that you're interested in?

P To be honest, I've got so many hobbies and they change quite frequently [*laughs*]. So one week I'll be really interested in maybe walking or running, the next week I'll be interested in... I don't know. I mean, I don't know if I'm allowed to say this, but I quite like just chilling and playing games. So yeah, I enjoy playing a lot of games. I'd say that's a hobby of mine.

Int **That's cool. I think it's good to have different interests, isn't it? Because obviously weather dependent and things, you don't always want to go for a run, do you, if it's raining?**

P Absolutely not. To be honest actually, I will just say that one of my [*laughs*] favourite things can be walking in the rain, but as long as I'm able to get somewhere and get dry afterwards...

Int **Yeah, makes total sense. So what's something that you're excited about in the near future? Have you got anything coming up that you're particularly looking forward to?**

P Yeah. So... [*pause*] sorry, can you repeat that question?

P That's a really good question. I mean, I don't have any holidays planned or anything like that, but I'm hopefully meeting up with friends soon to go paintballing. I suppose that's something to look forward to.
